Our dream is that **every** member of the family of the two St James engages wholeheartedly with regular planned giving by standing order.

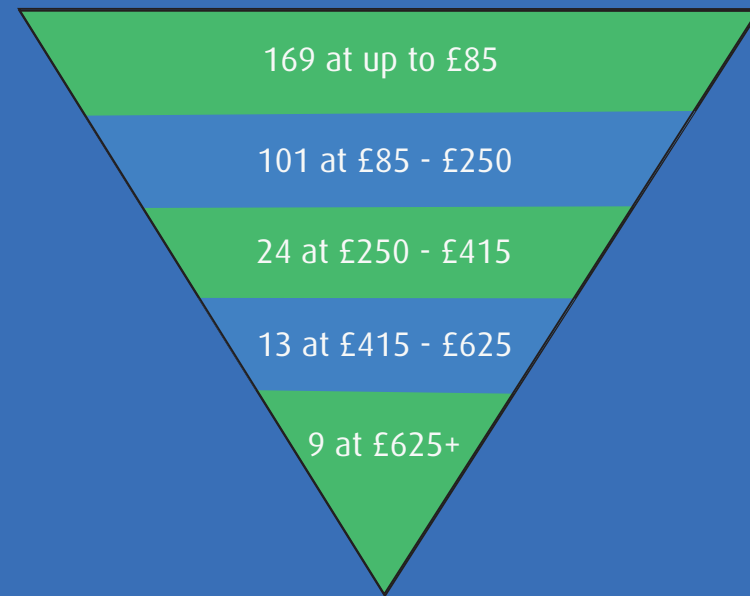
Currently 30% of those who consider St James to be their home church do not give regularly to the work of the church.¹
