Finding Windmill Farm

Directions from Witney

Coming from Witney on the A4095 turn left at crossroads in Clanfield towards Faringdon.

Drive through the village until you come to a field on the left hand side.

Go past Bushey Drive (on the right hand side) and you will then see a clear sign on the verge for Windmill Farm Conference Centre.
