

# GDPR Parent/Carer Contact Policy



In May 2018, new regulations General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force. The GDPR forms part of the data protection laws in the UK, together with the new Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA 2018)

As a result of GDPR regulations we need your consent for coaches to store your personal information and consent for the different ways in which we use it to communicate with you. If you do not consent to coaches storing your data, and communicating with you, you will not receive information regarding training and match fixtures.

Coaches will use various communication methods in their correspondence of training sessions and match fixtures. Please read the communication options below and give your consent to each individually.

- I consent to my phone number and email to be stored on the coach's phone and personal computer for communication purposes.
- I consent to receive emails<sup>1</sup>, both whole team<sup>2</sup> and individual, from team coaches, regarding team fixtures and SJFC events.
- I consent to receive text messages, both whole team and individual, from team coaches, regarding team fixtures and SJFC events.
- I consent to be part of a team WhatsApp group and receive WhatsApp<sup>3</sup> messages, from team coaches, regarding team fixtures and SJFC events.
- I consent that during sessions, emergency contact details and medical information will be held by the coach on a paper document.

## Children aged 14+ Contact Policy



In May 2018, new regulations General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force. The GDPR forms part of the data protection laws in the UK, together with the new Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA 2018)

As your child plays in an U14's team or older, we need your consent for coaches to store your child's personal information, and consent for the different ways in which they use it to communicate. As a parent/carer, you will be the primary contact for all communication. Should a coach need to contact your child you will also be copied in.

Coaches will use various communication methods in their correspondence of training sessions and match fixtures. Please read the communication options below and give your consent to each individually.

- Both I and my child give consent for my child's name, phone number and email to be stored on the coach's phone and personal computer for SJFC communication purposes
- I give consent for my child to receive emails<sup>4</sup>, both whole team<sup>5</sup> and individual, from team coaches, regarding team fixtures and SJFC events.
- I give consent for my child to receive whole team text messages, from team coaches, regarding team fixtures and SJFC events.
- I give consent for my child to be part of a team WhatsApp group and receive WhatsApp<sup>6</sup> messages, from team coaches, regarding team fixtures and SJFC events.
- In some instances I understand that coaches will communicate only with my child<sup>7</sup>.
- I understand that I will be copied into all communication sent to my child.
